II. Goals

To teach a group of 14 Nurses in the most important practical problems of Family Medicine

- Concepts of Family Medicine
- The role of Family Nurse (FN) in family Medicine system
- Insurance systems in Moldova and the role of Family nurses
- Continuous medical education of Family Nurses in Moldova
- Principles of ethics in practice of FN
- Patient in context of family; family as a member of team
- Informatics for nurses practice
- Team work, management, efficient communication
- Preventive medicine: health promotion for patients of different age, healthy food as a factor of health, healthy modus vivendi - place and role of FN
- Newborn, infant, child, adolescent - health promotion and preventive medicine; the most often medical problems - principles of care and management
- Medico-social problems: domestic violence, tuberculosis
- Palliative care

- Practical skills: screening for breast cancer, EKG, otoscopy, ophthalmoscopy, express lab tests

III. Performances

All planned goals were achieved. The participants appreciated very much the practical skills for breast cancer screening, otoscopy, ophthalmoscopy, express diagnostic tests and the new, interactive, principles of learning, focusing on practical side of activity.

IV. Unexpected results

The group of participants asked the team to continue this kind of training in other field of nurses activity

V. Challenges

- a. Expensive cost for rent of classrooms: we achieve an agreement with State Medical University and have used the conference rooms and clinical locations of the University
- b. We had not planned money for food: we used the money for transport for organizing coffee breaks for participants

VI. Influences

A. For participants:

- The participants realized the new increasing role, first in decision making and attitudes, of actual Family Nurses in the new conditions to the Family Medicine practice

B. For teaching staff:

- The participants were very open for discussion and enthusiastic, even in the difficult conditions (small salary, lack of informational possibilities (books in available language, especially for FM nurses) and technical equipment,) to participate in Foundation of Family Medicine in Moldova

VII. Results

For every topics (module) the teaching staff have prepared 2 maps: map of participants and map of formator, with basic theoretical information and for practical skills, tests for initial and final evaluation, clinical case for discussions.
